- The curriculum to be used for this class is highly scripted, so leaders will not have to wonder what they should be saying to keep the "chat" moving along (but of course, they also are free to add their own personal style into the conversation).
- Anyone who has been attending Newark UMC for at least six months, and who is age 18 or above, is eligible to become part of this elite team.
- Two persons will be on duty each Sunday, and will rotate in a manner to be decided on by the team.

The Christian Education team is confident that God’s Spirit will move the hearts of people who are willing to minister to our tweens – are you one of them?
