Report to: Senior Pastor

Background:

Newark United Methodist Church is a mid-sized congregation nestled in the midst of the college town of Newark, Delaware. The church is currently involved in a re-visioning effort which has identified an emphasis to be placed upon Christian Education and Youth/Young Adult Ministries in the next season. Four aspirational goals were identified as the church pursues ministry in these areas:

1. Build a community that focuses on a relationship with God
2. Create a culture of discipleship in the church
3. Increase the number of dynamic teachers from the congregation
4. Make disciples of the next generation

Welcoming Statement:

Description:

This position is a part-time pastoral and administrative position (35 hours per week) serving a dynamic and diverse congregation of approximately 300 congregants within the Methodist tradition. In addition to being involved in normal church life, this pastor will coordinate, develop and oversee ministry volunteer leaders primarily in the areas of:

- **Christian Education – Children and Families** (pre-kindergarten through 12th grade to include family life involvement)
- **Young Adult Ministries** (College through 35 years old)

The primary focus of this position is nurturing the spiritual formation of the people (participating in Christian Education and our Youth/Young Adults) touched by the ministries of NUMC. The pastor will equip and assist the volunteer leaders to coordinate and execute ministry in their areas. As necessary, this pastor will engage in the recruitment and training of additional volunteer leaders to meet the ministry needs of each area and work with the Senior Pastor to plan for growth of the ministries. He/She will participate and contribute at staff meetings, Church Council meetings, and other meetings as directed by the Senior Pastor. Providing support for worship services may be requested by the pastor as well. The Associate Pastor will orchestrate communication for the ministry areas of responsibility as well as monitor and report the status and progress of ministry in his/her areas of oversight.

Specific Duties

Christian Education – Children and Family Ministry

The Associate Pastor of Christian Education and Youth/Young Adult Ministries will work with the volunteer leaders to evaluate and select curricula which is Christ-centered and engaging for each age group. He/She will initiate with volunteer leaders to create annual budgets and plans for activities which will engage the children and families (family life involvement) in learning activities with the above aspirational goals in mind.

Typical duties in this area will or might include:

- In concert with the Children and Family Ministries Team, coordinate Christian Education and faith formation classes and related experiences for all age groups at NUMC.
- Support volunteer teachers and helpers with professional development (training and lesson planning), selection and ordering of curriculum and scheduling.
- Manage the budget for Christian Education by working closely with the Finance Committee.
- Planning of youth group meetings, mission trips and special activities.
- Participate in outreach ministries to youth within the community.
- Evaluate education ministries and spiritual formation activities to ensure they align with the church's mission, vision and priorities.
- Develop and facilitate the church's confirmation program with assistance from the Senior Pastor and Lay Leaders.

Young Adult Ministries

The Associate Pastor of Christian Education and Youth/Young Adult Ministries will develop volunteer leaders to engage young adults in activities and ministry which meets them at their points of interest and need in a culture of discipleship. He/She will provide spiritual support to volunteer leaders and work with leaders to create an annual budget and plans for young adults to mature in their walks with Christ and grow as leaders in their circles of influence.

Typical duties in this area will or might include:

- Oversee the development of a program that meets the needs young adults at NUMC, the community and their families to nurture their spiritual formation and provide a welcoming home to our younger congregants that align with the church's mission, vision and priorities.
- Oversee the development of a variety of programs +/-or activities that meet the specific needs and diversity of young adult groups in the church.
- Manage the budget for the Young Adult Ministries.
- Evaluate Young Adults ministries and spiritual formation activities to ensure they align with the church's mission, vision and priorities.
